Complying with the SOA CPD Requirement by following the Basic Requirement provisions of the SOA CPD Requirement found in Section B

Whom does this apply to?

Generally, it applies to SOA members who practice outside the United States or Canada or who are not members of the Faculty and Institute of Actuaries (United Kingdom) or the Institute of Actuaries of Australia. All members may follow the requirements in Section B of the SOA CPD Requirement, but we anticipate most members will use one of the alternative compliance standards:

- SOA members who practice in the United States will generally use the U.S. Qualification Standard.
- SOA members who practice in Canada will generally use the CIA Qualification Standard.
- SOA members who are members of the Faculty and Institute of Actuaries (United Kingdom) or who are subject to the U.K. Actuarial Profession's CPD Scheme will generally use the CPD Scheme of the Faculty and Institute of Actuaries.
- SOA members who are members of the Institute of Actuaries of Australia or who are subject to the Continuing Professional Development Standard of the Institute of Actuaries of Australia will use that standard to comply.

What do I need to do to comply?

During the two-year period 2009-2010:

- Earn 60 units of CPD credit in job-relevant and business and management skills (1 unit = 50 minutes).
- Earn at least 30 units in structured credit.
- Earn at least 7.5 units of structured credit from a source other than your employer.
- Earn at least 3 units of structured professionalism credit.
- Earn no more than 15 units of credit in business and management skills.

How do I attest compliance?

- Log in to My SOA.
- Once logged in, your SOA profile will display.
- Click the My Professional Development heading.
- Scroll down to your Continuing Professional Development section and click SOA CPD Status. The page, SOA CPD Attestation, will display your compliance status.
- Click on the Update Info button.
- Click the button that applies to your compliance status.

- If you click the first button certifying that you've fulfilled the requirement, you must click on the button(s) that identifies your method of compliance.
- Or, click the last button certifying that you haven't fulfilled the SOA CPD requirement.
- Finally, click Save. The change will take 24 hours to reflect within the Directory of Actuarial Memberships.
