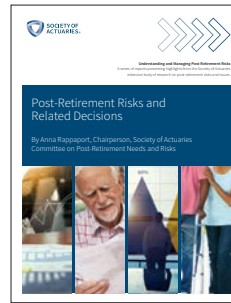




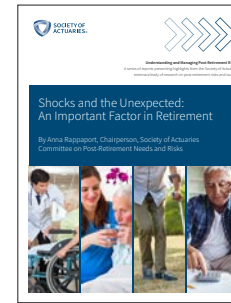
# Understanding & Managing Post Retirement Risks reports

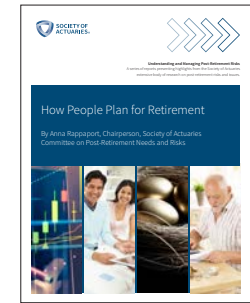
### Post-Retirement Risks and Related Decisions

Explores the shocks and unexpected expenses retirees face in retirement and links them to risk issues.



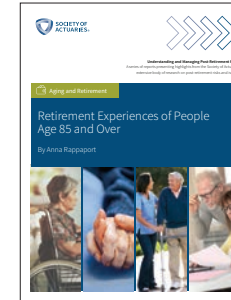
### How People Plan for Retirement
