A panel discussion, similar to those presented at the Boston and Chicago regional meetings, was presented by the following panel members: Victor E. Henningsen, John H. Miller, and Henry F. Rood. Mr. Leslie A. Cannon discussed the Canadian program for the accreditation of actuaries. An informal discussion period followed the panel presentations.

It was announced at this meeting that the other three actuarial organizations, namely, the Casualty Actuarial Society, the Conference of Actuaries in Public Practice, and the Fraternal Actuarial Association, had all officially approved a resolution favoring the organization of the Academy of Actuaries.

The Fellows of the Society of Actuaries present and voting at this meeting went on record as being in favor of the organization of the Academy of Actuaries by adopting unanimously the resolution printed on pages 136 and 137 of this volume of the *Transactions*. This resolution was previously adopted unanimously at the Boston and Chicago regional meetings of the Society.
