III. TABLES SHOWING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN WEIGHT, HEIGHT, AND GIRTH

A TABLE showing the average relationship between weight, height, and girth was developed in 1929 by Dr. Charles P. Clark and presented to the Association of Life Insurance Medical Directors of America in a paper entitled "Chest and Abdominal Measurements as Related to Height and Weight, with Presentation of Tables of Averages." The principal use made of this table was to check the reasonableness of weights reported on applications for insurance against the reported measurements of height and girth. The table was constructed from data on 9,392 approved applications. It assumed that there was a linear relationship between the ratio of weight to height and the three girth measurements—chest at inspiration, chest at expiration, and abdomen.

After publication of the *Build and Blood Pressure Study, 1959*, the Committee on Mortality under Ordinary Insurance and Annuities decided that it would be helpful to underwriters if new tables indicating the relationship between weight, height, and girth were developed, based on more extensive data and showing a range of credible weights rather than a single weight corresponding to a given height and girth.

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW TABLES

The *Build and Blood Pressure Study, 1959*, included a stratified sample of 290,000 policies on men and 70,000 policies on women with detailed information relating to weight and height. (See Memorandum B, *Build and Blood Pressure Study, 1959*, I, 224.) The sample strata consisted of:

- (i) 2 per cent of standard policies entering into the mortality study;
- (ii) all substandard policies for extreme heights, weights, or blood pressure entering into the mortality study;
- (iii) 20 per cent of other substandard policies entering into the mortality study; and
- (iv) 5 per cent of the policies rated for substandard occupation or impairments other than build or blood pressure.

This sample was used to determine average weights and heights as well as the distribution of weights by height, age, and sex. The same material was selected as the basis for constructing new tables that would indicate the average relationship between weight, height, and girth for *male* lives. More specifically, a stratified subsample of 106,000 policies on male lives was drawn from the 290,000 policies on male lives mentioned above so as

to obtain approximately the same number of cases in each age-height-weight cell. Cards comprising this sample were referred back to the contributing companies for entry of girth measurements—chest at expiration, chest at inspiration, and abdomen. The total number of cards returned with such additional information was 93,423. Because of incomplete data on some cards, only 65,081 cases were finally used in constructing the new tables.

The weight, height, and girth data on the 65,081 cases were reweighted so as to obtain distributions corresponding to the material used to determine average weights and heights in the *Build and Blood Pressure Study, 1959*. The resulting distributions were then used to calculate regression lines for the relationships between weight/height and the sum of the three girth measurements. In computing the standard deviation of these distributions, stratification was disregarded.

Table 1 was developed from two regression lines: one based on data for issue ages 25-29 used to determine the "expected" weights for issue ages under 40 and the other based on data for issue ages 45-49 used to determine the "expected" weights for issue ages 40 and over.

To test the results obtained with confidence limits at the 80 per cent confidence level, a sample of 1,083 policies on medically examined male lives taken from Metropolitan Life Insurance Company's issues of April-May, 1964, was reviewed. It was found that 75 per cent of the stated weights reported on the applications for these policies fell within the range defined by the confidence limits.

It is believed that Table 1 will meet the usual day-to-day underwriting needs for checking reported weights. A corresponding but very much more extensive table combined with Table 1 may be obtained from the office of the Society at a cost of \$1 for each combined set. The extensive table provides a higher degree of predictive accuracy and could be used to check on cases which are borderline by Table 1, particularly in those portions of the table relating to extreme values. The table was constructed from 40 regression lines, one for each of the 40 age-height groups defined in terms of age groups 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, and height groups 62"-64", 65"-67", 68"-70", 71"-73", and 74"-76". For each of these age-height groups different values of \bar{y} , \bar{x} , and b were obtained for the general regression equation

$$y = \bar{y} + b(x - \bar{x}) .$$

COMPARISON WITH 1929 TABLE

Table 2 compares the "expected" weights by Table 1 with those in Dr. Clark's 1929 Table for representative entries. It will be noted that

for extreme values Table 1 shows "expected" weights significantly different from those in the older table. Since these portions of the older table were based on rather limited data, Table 1 can be regarded as more reliable.

These "expected" weights corresponding to specific height and girth measurements were computed from the following two regression equations:

1. Ages under 40

$$y = W/H = 2.3420 + 0.0319773 (x - 105.23) ;$$

2. Ages 40 and over

$$y = W/H = 2.4660 + 0.0299479 (x - 110.41) ;$$

where $y = W/H$ ratio, W = weight, H = height, and x = sum of three body measurements.

The confidence limits at the 80 per cent confidence level were calculated for each regression line and tabulated alongside the "expected" weights. These confidence limits are shown in Table 1. For each age, height, and sum of girth measurements the confidence limits show the range of weights in

which 80 out of every 100 randomly drawn sample measurements might be expected to fall.¹ For any large group of applicants of a particular age having a particular height and sum of girth measurements, 80 per cent may in the long run be expected to have weights within these confidence limits and 20 per cent may similarly be expected to have weights outside this range. Consequently, if an underwriter finds that a reported weight is below the lower limit indicated in Table 1, he can assume that there is only a 10 per cent chance that the weight is as low as reported. The standard formulas used in calculating these confidence limits are given in the Appendix. Also shown in the Appendix are values for the several parameters in the formulas, which can be used to calculate confidence limits at other confidence levels.

TEST OF TABLE 1

A sample of approximately 200 applications on medically examined lives was drawn from the files of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company to test Table 1 in comparison with the 1929 Clark Table. Based on Metropolitan Life's ratings for weight by age and height, each application was assigned underwriting classifications based on (a) the reported weight, (b) the expected weight based on the Clark Table, and (c) the "expected" weight based on Table 1. The results of this test turned out to be as follows:

¹ Strictly speaking, the confidence limits here used define a range extending above and below the "expected" weight, and the confidence level may be considered for practical purposes as indicating the probability that the "true" value of the "expected" weight for a given age, height, and the sum of girth measurements will in repeated sampling be enclosed within the range covered by the confidence limits.

If rechecks of the reported weight were ordered on all cases where the rating for the reported weight was more favorable than for the "expected" weight, the Clark Table would call for a recheck of 22.9 per cent ($14.1 + 1.5 + 7.3$) of the cases, whereas Table 1 would call for a recheck of only 7.3 per cent.

Alternatively, rechecks of the reported weight might reasonably be ordered only on cases where the reported weight fell outside the confidence limits at the 80 per cent confidence level shown in Table 1 and the "expected" weight required a higher rating. Cases falling within the range of the confidence limits shown in Table 1 could then be accepted. The table below summarizes the results of reviewing the sample on this basis.

The 80.6 per cent of the cases falling within range of the confidence limits indicate the sample distribution conforms to the 80 per cent confidence level.

The alternate procedure would call for a recheck of only 3.9 per cent of the cases as compared with 7.3 per cent under the first procedure. This difference is due largely to the fact that under the alternate procedure cases with reported weights falling within range are considered acceptable, even though the rating for the reported weight might be less than the rating for the "expected" weight.

It should be noted that the percentage of recheck cases would drop below 3.9 per cent if a company did not normally recheck weights when the examiner states that he actually weighed the applicant.

APPENDIX

The upper and lower limits shown in Table 1 were calculated by using the following formula for the confidence interval of the W/H ratios based on the regression line of the W/H ratios on the sums of the three body measurements.

The confidence interval is a function of the sample values only, once α is given. If $\alpha = 10$ per cent, a 90 per cent confidence limit is obtained (see Fig. 1).



For $N > 30$, tables of the normal curve can be used because the distribution approaches the normal form as $n \rightarrow \infty$.

Example.—For Table 1, age under 40, t_a at 80 per cent, the range of expected W/H ratios is:

Thus for any given height (H) and sum of three measurements (x), a range of expected weights (W) can be calculated.

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
