NOMINATIONS and **ELECTIONS** Process

Learn about the nominations and elections process for the Society of Actuaries (SOA). Gain insights into the process for electing members to the SOA Board of Directors. One president-elect and five elected Board members are elected each year.



The Nominating Committee reviews the composition of continuing Board members

and complete a questionnaire covering experience, strategic thinking, core competencies and teamwork skills.



The Nominating Committee reviews the questionnaires and interview results, according to skills and criteria to determine the election ballot. The committee submits the ballot to the Board for approval. The committee then notifies these endorsed candidates.

The election results are sent to a team of SOA leaders to review and verify the election results. The candidates are notified. The SOA publicly announces the elected candidates.

Eligible voting members are encouraged to vote. Voting is confidential and anonymous.

Nominees who have not been endorsed can seek petition support. They must notify the Nominating Committee about the position for which they seek petition



The SOA develops an online petition site. Eligible voting members receive an email to support petitions. Petition support is optional and is kept anonymous.



The SOA announces the final slate of candidates on the ballot. The SOA posts candidates' elections questionnaire, candidate webpage and message to members.

To qualify for the ballot by petition, nominees must obtain petition support equal to or

greater than 10 percent of votes cast for president-elect in the previous year's election.

About the SOA Nominating Committee
