The President-Elect announced that word of the death of three members had been received since the annual meeting of the Society: Samuel A. Miller and Otto C. Richter, Fellows; and Harold H. Buckman, Associate. The members stood for a moment in silent respect. Obituaries are printed elsewhere in this number of the *Transactions*.

The President-Elect advised that minutes of the regional spring meeting held June 1 and 2, 1961, as printed in the *Transactions*, Volume XIII, on pages 271 to 277, inclusive, and those of the regional spring meeting held June 8 and 9, 1961, as printed in the *Transactions*, Volume XIII, on pages 278 to 282, inclusive, had been approved at the regional spring meeting held March 22 and 23, 1962.

The Secretary presented a summary of the business transacted by the Board of Governors since the last annual meeting. This summary was previously presented at the regional meeting held March 21 and 22, and is printed in the minutes of that meeting in this number of the *Transactions*.

The Vice-General Chairman of the Education and Examination Committee, Paul Rotter, gave a report on the progress in the development of the new syllabus for the Society's examinations.

The President-Elect read a telegram from President Jenkins expressing his regret at his inability to attend the meeting.

The meeting then proceeded to the presentation and discussion of papers as printed in this number of the *Transactions*.

A welcome was extended by the President-Elect to the new Fellows and Associates who were attending the meeting for the first time since the attainment of their present rank.

Vice-President November then presided over the informal discussion of Topic I of the session on subjects of general interest.

The meeting adjourned for lunch at 12:20 P.M.

The members reassembled in two separate meetings at 2:00 P.M. for the discussion of topics of special interest. One session on Individual Life Insurance was presided over by Mr. Dale Gustafson, the other on Employee Benefit Plans was presided over by Mr. Donald B. Warren. These meetings adjourned at approximately 4:45 P.M.

Vice-President November opened the meeting on Friday, April 6, at 9:30 A.M. and presided over the continued discussion of Topic I of the subjects of general interest and later over Topic III. Vice-President Jenkins presided over the discussion of Topics II and IV.

The President-Elect closed the meeting after thanking all those who had taken part in the discussions. The meeting adjourned at 12:15 P.M.

The Smaller Company Forum was called to order at 2:00 P.M. on Friday. Mr. Will Mullens presided over the discussion of the topics as Chairman. The meeting adjourned at approximately 4:30 P.M.
