

U.S. Flooding Reports


Actuaries should consider the potential for increased flooding risks across business practices: life, health, and property and casualty.

How Climate Change Affects Precipitation

A warming atmosphere that holds more water vapor **RESULT:** Storms produce


more rain

Altered atmospheric circulation patterns

RESULT: A change in when, where and how much rain falls

Increased evaporation rates

RESULT: Higher precipitation amounts
