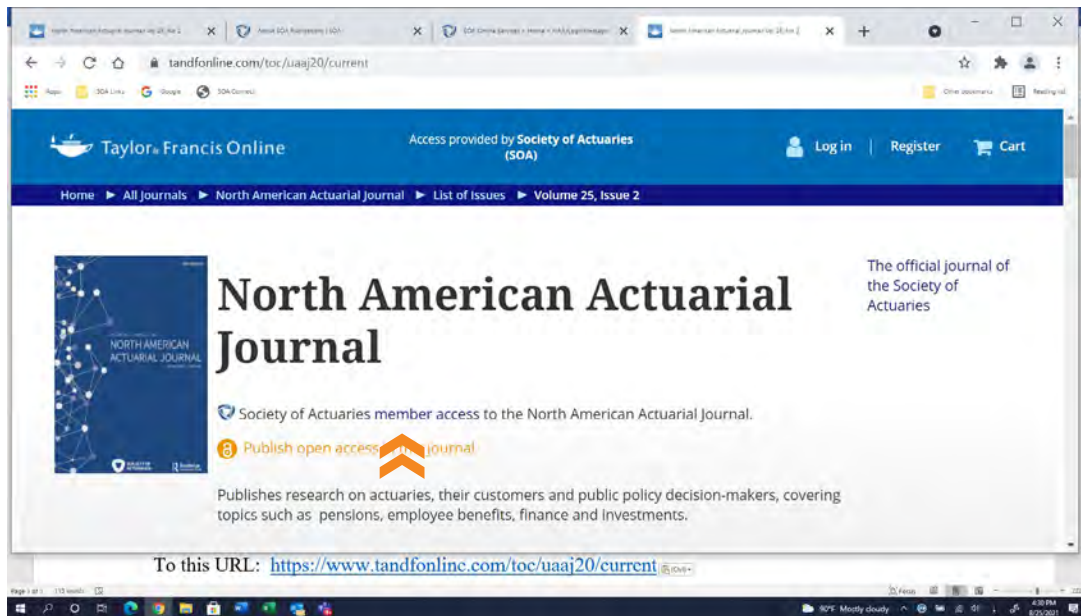


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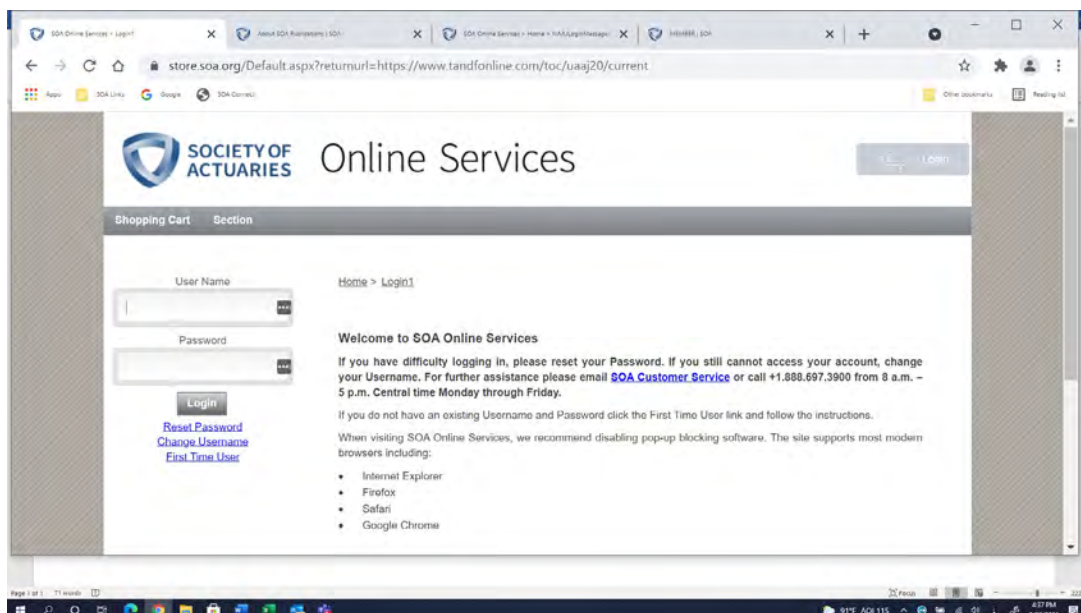
MEMBER LOG IN AND ACCESSING ARTICLES

Select “member access,” in the blue text, as illustrated above in “Society of Actuaries member access to the North American Actuarial Journal.”

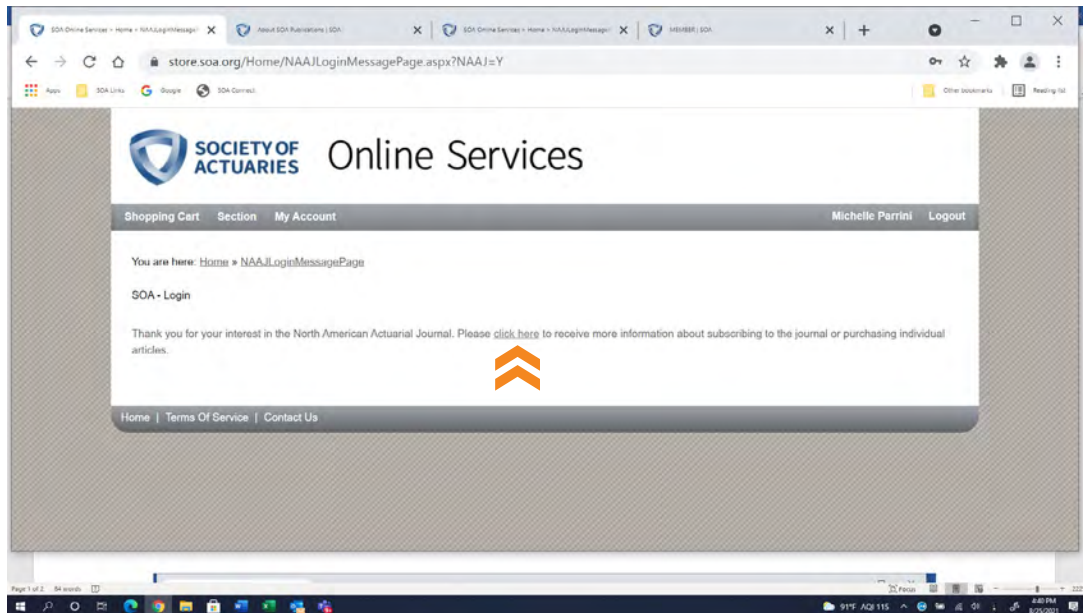
Selecting the blue text “member access” will take you to the login page for your SOA account, illustrated below. Enter your user name and password and select the “Login” command.



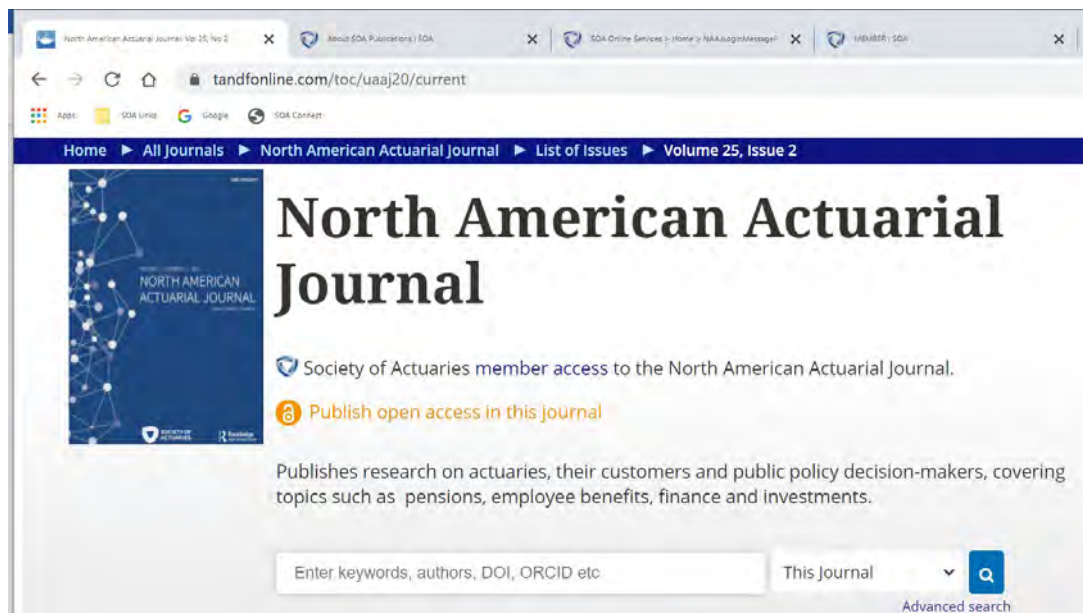
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The next window you will see is the one for your SOA account, as illustrated below. Select “[click here](#).”
