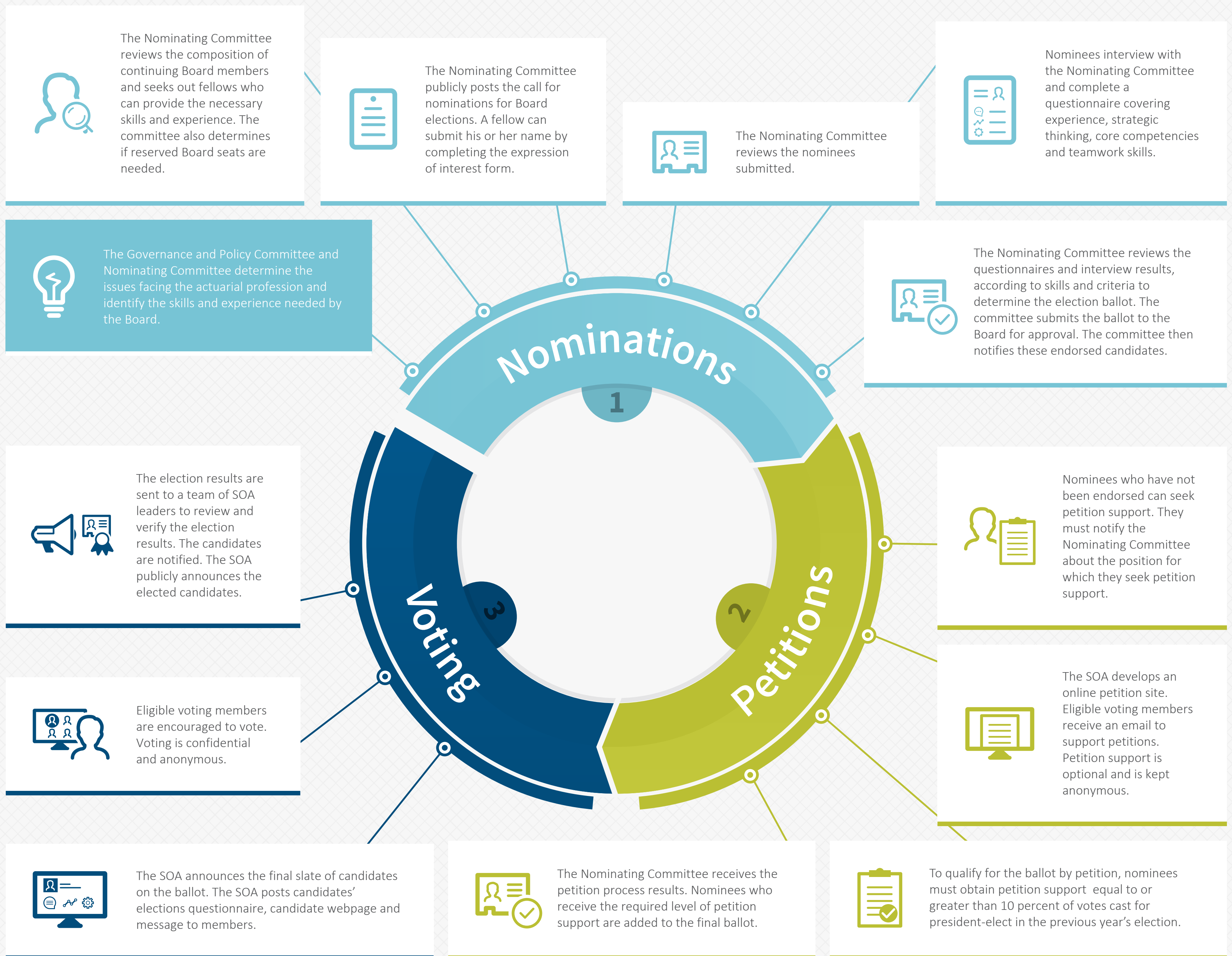




NOMINATIONS and ELECTIONS Process

Learn about the nominations and elections process for the Society of Actuaries (SOA). Gain insights into the process for electing members to the SOA Board of Directors. One president-elect and five elected Board members are elected each year.



About the SOA Nominating Committee



The committee consists of nine fellows who nominate candidates for election, in accordance with SOA policies. Each committee member serves a three-year term and no more than two terms each. The SOA Governance and Policy Committee identifies and appoints Nominating Committee members.

About Eligible Voting Members



Fellows as well as associates who have been members of the SOA for five years or more are entitled to vote in the Board election.
